Below are important updates relating to repairs and impacts that involve your unit. Please review the notice thoroughly and contact us with any questions or concerns you may have.

Water Restriction Notices

Water restrictions impacting the kitchen sink and dishwasher of 05' units 805-3405 will begin on Tuesday, July 18th, 2023 through Friday, July 28th, 2023. **During the dates referenced, residents may not use their kitchen sink and dishwashers 24/7 until further notice. This includes after hours and weekends.**

PLEASE DO NOT USE YOUR DISHWASHER AND KITCHEN SINK UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE AS THIS WILL CAUSE DAMAGE IN UNITS BELOW.

Water Shut-Downs for Domestic Repairs

Water shut-downs will commence on Monday, July 17th, 2023 through Thursday, July 20th, 2023, from 8:00am to 5:00pm each day in order to proceed with certain portions of the active plumbing repairs in the 05' stack. **These shut-downs will affect adjacent units due the existing plumbing configuration. Below is the anticipated schedule for the required water shut-downs:**

Monday, July 17 th , 2023	All units on floors 27 through 32	9:00am to 5:00pm	Entire unit (all water)
Tuesday, July 18 th , 2023	All units on floors 21 through 28	9:00am to 5:00pm	Entire unit (all water)
Wednesday, July 19 th , 2023	All units on floors 15 through 20	9:00am to 5:00pm	Entire unit (all water)
Thursday, July 20 th , 2023	All units on floors 8 through 14	9:00am to 5:00pm	Entire unit (all water)

A notice will be provided at the completion of each day to inform residents when water has been restored. We thank you for your patience and cooperation while we complete these repairs.

Concrete Coring – Common Areas

Starting Monday, July 17th, 2023 through Friday, July 28th, 2023 from 8:00am to 5:00pm construction crews will commence with concrete coring in the common area in order to route the new domestic mains. During this time, you will hear construction noise and vibration while coring work is being conducted. Please plan accordingly for the noise and impacts.
